



Lebanon Winter Farmers' Market Application 2011-2012

Please join us for the Fifth Season of the Lebanon Winter Farmers' Market on the third Saturday of the month, November through April. The market will take place at the Lebanon United Methodist Church, on 18 School Street, from 10:00AM to 1:00PM.

The market gives vendor precedence to Agricultural Vendors, but is excited to accept Craft and Prepared food vendors. **Craft Vendors:** All craft vendors are asked to submit a photograph of their work or speak directly with the market coordinator. As always, all items must be hand crafted by you. We will accept crafters on a case-by-case basis, giving precedence to products using natural and agricultural materials. **Prepared Food Vendors:** In an effort to support local agriculture and ready-made foods, **we are asking all prepared food vendors to use 25% local ingredients and advertise this on their product.** Vendors preparing their own agricultural products (for instance, elk burgers or pulled pork sandwiches) will be counted as Ag vendors and given first precedence at the market. If vendors cannot use local products, they will be given a booth only if space allows. All prepared food vendors must comply with NH food licenses. <http://lebanonfarmersmarket.org/vending.htm>

In an effort to recruit specialty products and expand the product offerings at the market, we have a **Cooperative Booth** vending option. Vendors who sell products that are not already sold at the market will be given the option of cooperative selling. How it works: a current vendor can agree to sell a specialty product for another vendor (milk, soft cheese, yogurt, etc). All cooperative booth items will be reviewed by a product committee before the product is accepted into the market.

The market itself will operate essentially the same as years past, with vendors able to unload at the double doors on the side of the church beginning at 8:30AM. Some tables are available - please specify on your application if you need a table. We plan to have live music all of the markets and continue to promote the EBT and Debit Card program.

Booth spaces are 8x5 feet, with additional space available upon request. Please send a detailed description of each product you plan to sell. All items must be approved by the Market Coordinator before sales can be made.

The Market runs rain, snow, ice or shine! All vendors are expected to attend the markets they register for. Please call ahead at least 24 hours before the market in order to cancel a space.

Directions to Lebanon United Methodist Church: The Lebanon United Methodist Church is on School Street, near Colburn Park. As you approach the park with the Fire Station on your right, bear right onto Route 120 South/School Street. The church is almost immediately on your right, a grey building with good signage. Use the driveway to the left of the church for unloading .

Vendor Fees:

Full season (6 weeks) \$18 per market (plus one-time \$10 registration fee) = **\$118**
Partial season \$22 per market (plus one-time \$10 registration fee)

Vendor Fees are due by November 1st but will be accepted throughout the season if there is space

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
